- 3. Photo of an iris with a pet, wildlife or garden art.

# **Contest Requirements:**

- · Only original personal photos taken by you may be submitted
- Each participant can submit a maximum of 2 photos in each of the 3 categories, in JPEG format.
- · A participant can only win in one category
- · The photos should be high-resolution and numbered in sequence.
- The submissions should be sent via email to wnyisphotocontest2024@gmail.com
- A copy of the entry form must accompany each submission along with the entry form containing the jpeg number, category, and a brief description of the photo.
- · An email confirmation will be sent once the photo is received.
- · Printed photos will not be accepted.

## **Judges Criteria for Western New York Iris Society Photo Contest**

Every judge will interpret an image based on their own knowledge and experience. This is one of the benefits of having a panel of 3 judges as opposed to having one individual judge.



**Composition** - refers to the aesthetic arrangement of visual elements (background, object, lights) to form a cohesive picture. The photo must possess elements of creativity and must look or feel unique. Composition is also vital in the expression of emotion or message that the photo can portray.



**Technical Skill and Quality** - refers to the photo's quality in its digital format as well as the technical skill required to take the shot. Photography concepts (such as the "Rule of Thirds", leading lines, and color theory) should be evident and well-used. Should the photo not use these concepts /guidelines, then there must be a visually clear purpose for subverting them. Factors that affect the image quality category include whether or not the photo is perfectly focused, the tones and white balance, the amount of noise in the photo, and how it was post produced or edited.



**Overall Impression/Impact** - Because photography is a visual medium, the impact of a photographic work is an important factor to question..The score will be based on how the judge perceives the photo as a whole.

### Entries will be selected and judged in one of the (3) categories.

- 1. Iris in a landscape (Beside to show the garden or landscape)
- 2. Closeup of an iris (whole or part of the iris flower I showing)
- 3. Photo of an iris with a pet, wildlife or garden art
